### Change of Appetite

Several weeks ago, Pastor Sis called Bro. Bill and reminded him of a prophecy he gave her. He told her that her appetite was going to change — that she was going to start eating foods she never liked before, and she would no longer have an appetite for certain foods that she did like.

She continued by telling him about having lunch with her friend, Beth. They had been talking and eating for awhile when Beth suddenly asked why she was eating all of that lettuce when she didn't even like lettuce. Pastor Sis was surprised, not even realizing that she had been eating it. She told Beth that she didn't know, but that it was good.

Last week, Pastor Sis called again — all excited. She had just come from the doctor, who asked her what she was doing to lose weight. She had lost 15 pounds in one month. She said that she hadn't been doing anything, but that she had been prayed for and that her eating habits had changed. Things that she never liked before, she is now eating. Other things she used to crave no longer appeal to her.

### No Hysterectomy

Several months ago, the doctor had told Pastor Sis that she needed a hysterectomy. She was in extreme pain with an eight centimeter cyst. Three different times she was scheduled for surgery, but when she arrived at the hospital, they sent her home each time because of minor

hindrances such as a cough or cold. After being sent home the second time, she even decided to get a second opinion from a different doctor, but his diagnosis agreed with the first, that surgery was, indeed, necessary.

Both Bro. Bill and myself had already prophesied to her separately that she didn't need to have that surgery. Now, the doctor has given her a good report that she no longer needs the surgery. He told her that the cyst is shrinking. In fact, it has already shrunk in half, and is now only four centimeters. Thank God!

### Her Chains are Gone

We became acquainted with Linda Francis several years ago when we began the Miracle Broadcast in Hamilton, Ohio. She has been a faithful partner with our radio ministry ever since, and we thank God for her prayers and support.

In March, Linda came to a Miracle Service at Breaking Chains Worship Center expecting to receive her miracle. Many years ago, she went for a stress test, but

didn't expect to hear the doctor's report that she needed a double lung transplant. Her condition continued to grow worse, and it wasn't long before she was permanently put on oxygen. That was seven years ago. She described it like being in prison, having to have it everywhere she went.

During the altar service, Linda made her way to the front of the church, with unrelenting faith to receive her healing. Bro. Bill instructed her to remove her oxygen, telling her that she no longer needed it. When he laid hands on her, she fell to the floor by the power of God, and came up with a big smile across her face. Bill walked her back and forth, and then told her to run around the sanctuary. Still smiling, she returned, breathing easy — with no oxygen tank.

Her healing was tested the very next week when she planned to go and pray for another woman with breathing problems. Linda was attacked with the same old symptoms, and was struggling to breathe. However, she stood her ground, refusing to allow the devil to put sickness back on her. She was determined to glorify God with her healing by showing and telling others that God is alive and that he still heals today! She called Bill for prayer reinforcement, and in agreement, they bound the enemy. The symptoms left, and she has been breathing free ever since.

## A MOTHER'S LOVE

*Who can find a virtuous woman? For her price is far above rubies . . . Her children arise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praiseth her. (Proverbs 31:10, 28)*

A mother's love is a mere glimpse of God's sacrificial and unending love for us. It is truly a gift from God, and I am blessed to have been raised by a godly mother who loved me very much and taught me about Jesus.

Walk with me a moment down Memory Lane. Mom married Dad when she was only 15 and had me (the first of six) when she was 17. She and Dad will celebrate their 60th wedding anniversary in September.

Mom has always been very shy and backward. She doesn't like being noticed and gets really embarrassed if she is the center of attention, like at the golden wedding anniversary party we threw for her and Dad. She is most comfortable sitting on the back pew at church. Mom has a beautiful voice and would sit in her rocking chair and sing all of her kids to sleep throughout the years, but she wouldn't dream of getting up in church and singing a "special."

On the other hand, you could always count on mom to bake cookies for Vacation Bible School or school parties; cook food for a family when someone died; and have the evangelist over for supper. There was an Air Force Base about 15 miles from us, and many times the service men would visit our church. Mom was sympathetic to these young men, knowing they were away from their families. Many times she would invite them home for dinner and the afternoon until time for the evening service. She gave them a home-cooked meal and made them feel like part of the "family."

Sometimes, moms have to be willing

to sacrifice for their children. When I was in the 6th grade, our class was taking a trip to Chicago, and I was so excited. Mom stayed up until late in the night sewing me a new dress for my trip—that was back when girls had to wear dresses to school. Mom even made my wedding gown, and I didn't pick out a simple pattern, either. It had tiers of lace, plus intricate sequins and beadwork.

Then came the day when I got the disease, guillian barre, and couldn't walk or take care of myself. Being a mom, myself, I can only imagine how she felt seeing me like that. It doesn't matter how old your kids are, moms hurt when their kids hurt, especially when they're helpless to make it all better.

I didn't have anyone else to take care of me while my husband worked, and mom came over every day. Not only did she take care of me, but she also cleaned house, did the laundry, cooked, and took care of my three kids when they came home from school. That was truly a sacrifice of love, because then, she had to go home and do it all over again there.

I appreciate her and thank God for a special mom who's been there for me when I needed her most. She's a mom who taught by example—such as praying and reading her Bible every day. Yes, we've had our differences, just like most mothers and daughters do at times, but she has always loved me and taught me how to be a respectable wife and woman of God.

Motherhood is a big responsibility. Words can't describe the love you feel looking down and seeing your tiny newborn baby for the first time and holding that child close in your

arms. You want only the best life possible for them.

How disappointing it is when you discover that you can't always give them the best! How frustrating it is when, sometimes, you don't know what really is best for them! My three children are all so different from each other that what I thought was best for one of them wasn't necessarily best for the other two.

How helpless you feel when you realize that you can't always protect your children from being hurt! In fact, there may even be times when you, yourself, make mistakes and inadvertently hurt them, and you wonder how you can ever make it right again. How heartbreaking it is when you see your children make mistakes that can affect them for the rest of their lives, and you can't do anything about it.

These are the times when you have to humble yourself before God and admit your inabilities and failures. It's during these times that you must give your children to God and trust Him with them.

Years ago, God spoke to me and said, *"You know how much you love your children. . . I love them much more than you do."* When I understood that God loved my kids a lot more than I did, I was free to release them into His care. I knew He could do a much better job with them than I could. I'm only human, and my wisdom is foolishness in His eyes. God has a personalized plan for each of our five children, and I'm believing that his perfect plan will be fulfilled in each one of them. He can do what I can't, and His unconditional, unending love will never leave or forsake them.

For those of you who having been to the Annual *Preaching Under the Stars* Camp Meeting (which continues to grow), this will replace the temporary 8x16 stage that had to be built and taken down every year. We will also be able to use it for other events throughout the year.



It will be 16x32, almost twice the size of our old stage. We are estimating that it will cost around \$3000. Volunteers are ready and anxious to help with its construction once the building permit has been approved.
